Anyone whose life he touched misses him terribly. His work will be carried on with the help of his family - Joe, Linda and Jerry.


Message from the Waterfront Director

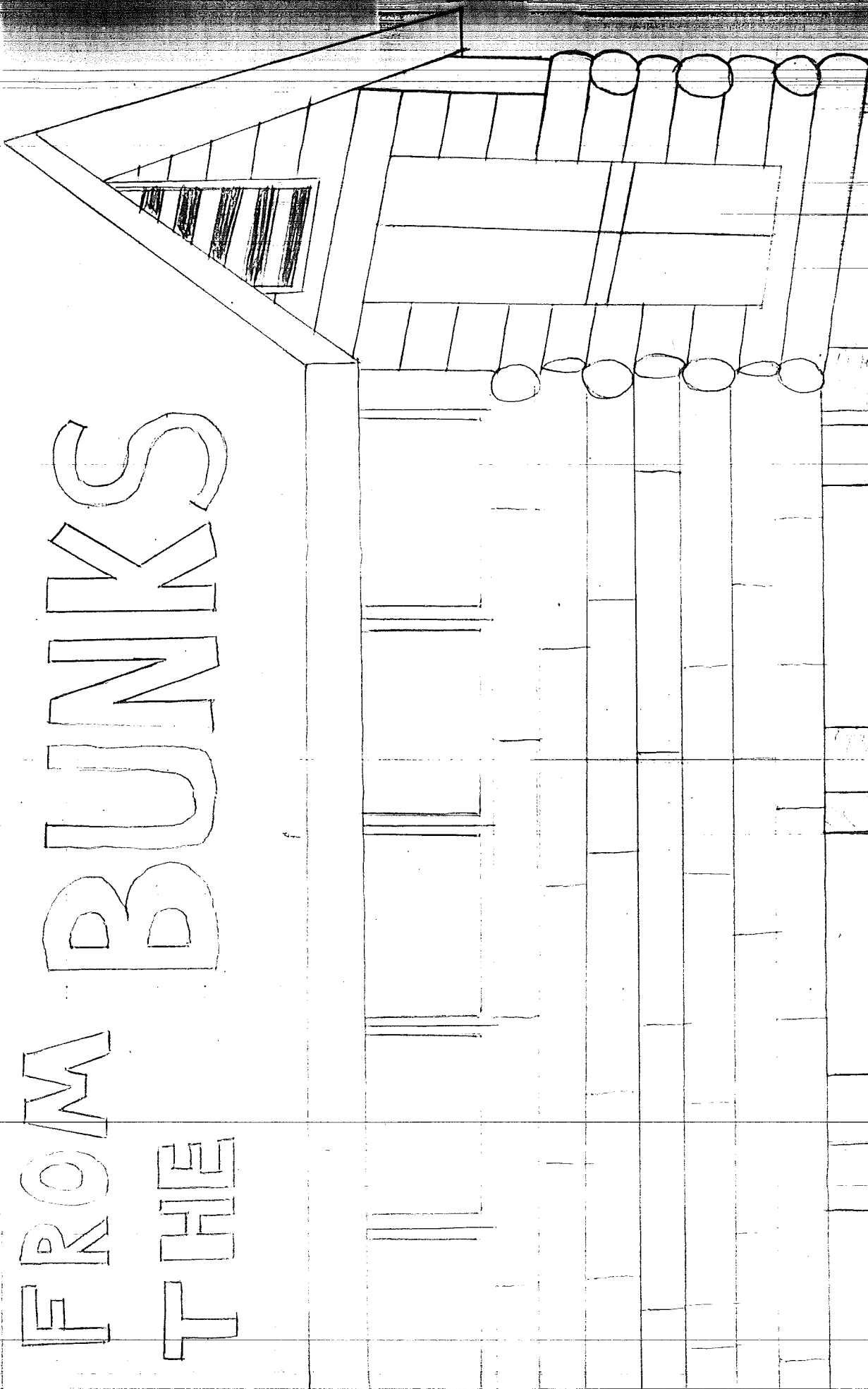
