## **LETTER FROM THE WATERFRONT DIRECTOR**

Each year when the Waterfront Director is asked to write a letter for the Spirit, the first thing that comes into his mind is "What can I really say about the waterfront?" This being my second year as the Waterfront Director, I can say from experience that it was certainly the first thought in my mind last year. However, my problem this year was not what to write about, but what to forget to include. In other words, there is so much to talk about this year, and I hope I don't forget anything.

To begin with, nothing could have been accomplished this year without the leadership and expertise of my Co-Waterfront Director, Caleb Englander. Caleb and I divided the program into two separate areas this summer, swimming and small crafts. Caleb headed up the swimming direction while I ran the boating program. Both halves were extremely successful!

In a waterfront sense, successful usually has one meaning: safe. This year Caleb and I redesigned the meaning of successful at the waterfront. Not only were there zero injuries, but a number of new programs were instituted as well. Firstly, eight newly contributed kayaks expanded our boating program. There really wasn't one day when a kayak could not be found somewhere on the lake. Secondly, a new tube in the shape of a jet ski added a new dimension to our tubing activity. Thirdly, our maintenance man, Norman Scott, constructed a brand new waterslide to be used on the Old Timer's Dock. The waterslide surpassed any idea of how well Caleb and I thought it would go. From the start, the slide had kids flying off the dock, safely, in almost every possible manner.

The last thing we added to the waterfront was a quality sailing program, where kids would take a two week course and, if successful, get certified by the Red Cross in Basic Sailing. I was in charge of the sailing instruction, and in full honesty, I would have liked to have seen more sailboats out there. However, in my many years at the West End House, I've learned to play with the hand you're dealt. In this respect, the sailing classes went incredibly well. Over twenty-five kids were certified and another twenty or so are on their way. All of the campers who took the sailing class learned a lot and had fun, I hope.

Aside from being blessed with several innovations, the waterfront was also lucky to have a number of valuable staff as well. To name a few, Andrew Berger, Jared Auerbach, and Adam Avakian did a great job teaching swim classes. In addition, Geoff Dancey and Mike Santosuosso were huge assets in both the boating and tubing activities.

In conclusion, this was the best year I have ever seen as both a counselor and director at the waterfront. The program has a great deal of energy and enthusiasm, and will continue to improve and grow in the years to come. Thank you once again to all the staff who made it possible, especially Caleb and the other swimming instructors. Hope to see you next year!


LETTER FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR
