Michael Kita served as Camp Doctor for seven summers, beginning in the late 1980's. He would arrive each summer with his family (wife Jean, daughter Rebecca, son Jonathan, and a friend or two of his children) and stay for a week, sometimes two. Over the years he became a true friend to so many of us – a man who took a personal interest in the campers and staff. He was a most caring individual, an excellent medical practitioner, a generous and kindly gentleman, a family person, a jogger (who would think nothing of “running” Hessian Hill), and a man of great intellect and wit.

His annual visits to camp were always anticipated and truly enjoyed by everyone. He got to know everyone, would keep in touch with people over the winter, would make himself available for consultation during the summer weeks when he was not at camp, was a judge for Song Night on more than one occasion, and became a real West Ender.

In September 1997 Dr. Kita was diagnosed with a brain tumor. He fought the gallant fight and, indeed, at one point it appeared he was going to beat the odds. However, it was not to be.

Dr. Kita passed away in August of 1998. He loved life, loved his family, and loved the West End House Camp. We loved him, too, and shall miss his warmth, his presence, his care and concern, and his wit. A Moment of Silence in his memory was observed before breakfast on August 13th.
