
Message from the Boating Director

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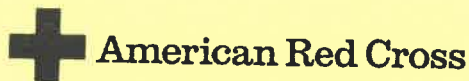
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Iron Man Advanced Life Saving

Jimmy Stoller, Judd Brandeis, and Kevin Lustig are a group of men who have dedicated a lot of hard work and many years to the W.E.H.C. In Dave Regensburger's first year at camp he accomplished a feat that took these men many years to accomplish. Captained by Mike Andelman, a long time member of ALS, Brian Bloch, Scott Eagerman, Todd Grossman, Issa Al-Aweel, Ron Cochran, and Mike Lampkin, all passed the course. Passing an ALS course at camp requires that everyone wakes up at 6:00 A.M. and goes through class until about first bell. Twenty hours of class time, passing a written test, and completing six rescues are all required to pass the class. With two full days left in camp we found ourselves about 8 hours short of completing the required amount of hours. As the rest of the camp went to Funtown U.S.A., the dedicated staff men spent the remaining 8 hours down at the waterfront. On the last day of camp the class passed the written and swimming portions of the test. This leaves the camp in good shape in terms of waterfront safety with 9 ALS's (including Matt Holt, Gilbert Michelson, and Ed Sarcia) and one Water Safety Instructor (David Regensburger).

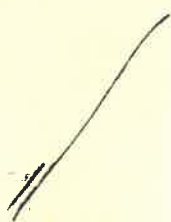

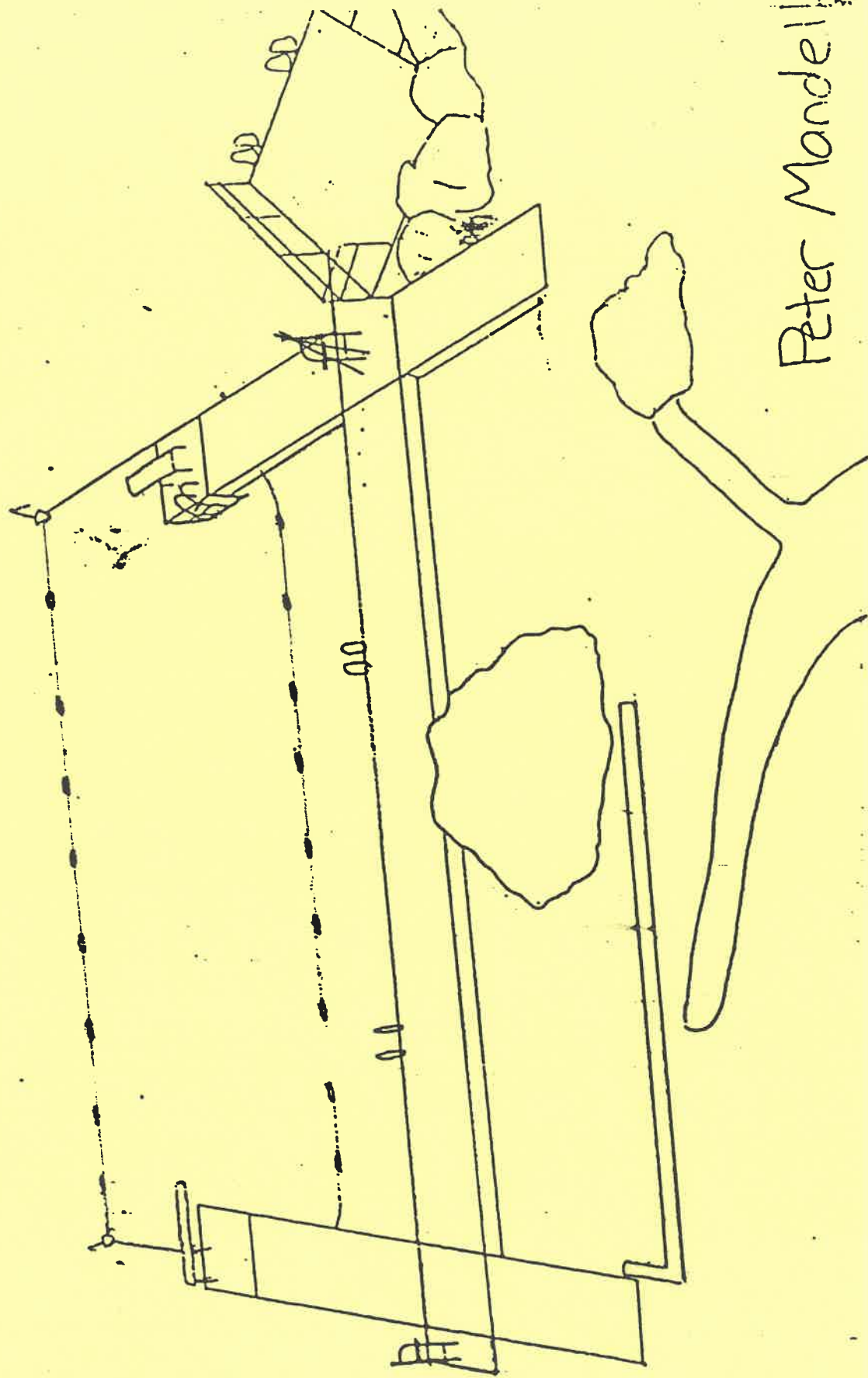
