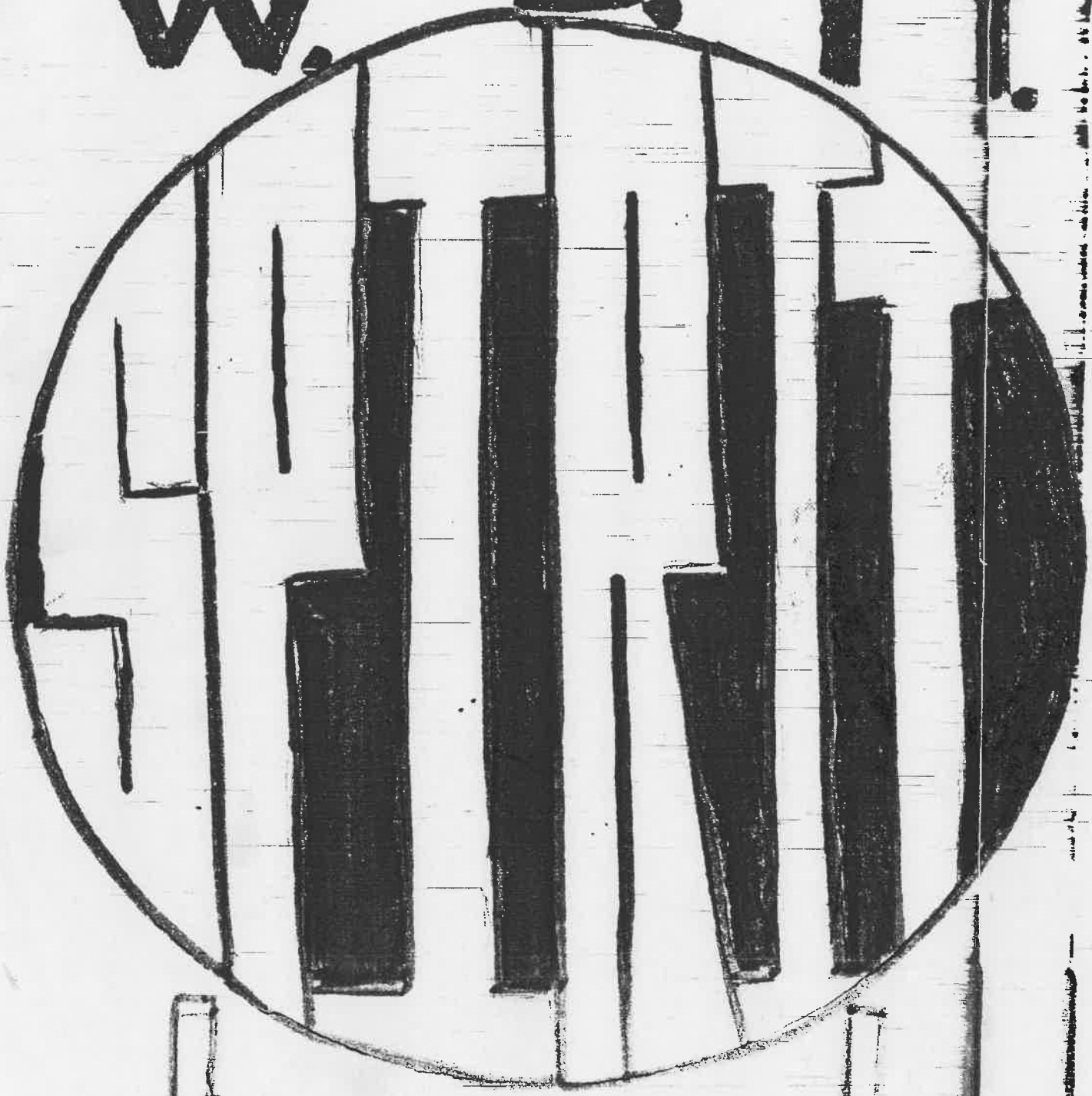

LETTER FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR

When I was fourteen, I overheard my counselor, Alex Berger, ask another staff man "What can we do to make today an exciting day?" I remembered that, and in my two years as program director I have always used that question as my guiding principle. This year, between camp and bunk trips, intercamp sports, fantastic night activities, the West End Carnival, superstars, and other new or improved camp programs, and with the efforts of a super staff, I think we would have made Alex proud, just about every day.

1991 was a tremendous summer for West End in every way. The camp boasted a staff of 40 counselors, filled with W.E.H. veterans who really know what West End House is all about. A hard working nurse was here all summer taking care of our medical needs, and our cooks did a splendid job of the task of feeding 160 West Enders.

In intercamp sports, W.E.H. was a force which other camps feared. We went to the semi-finals of the Robin Hood 13 & Under soccer tourney, and the finals of the Samoset baseball tourney. West End won both the Robin Hood 13 & Under and the 15 & Under basketball tournaments, prompting their program director to label W.E.H. a "basketball powerhouse." (In fact, we didn't lose a hoop game all summer). To top it all off, we dominated Robin Hood's 15 & Under baseball tourney. We played a great variety of games from 9 & Under newcomb to staff basketball, and lived up to our reputation as a camp that always plays hard.

In terms of camp and sportsmanship, the 1991 color war was the best I've seen. Both coaching staffs did an exemplary job, and their hard work in preparation was extremely evident during both the games and song night. The campers followed their coach's example and pushed themselves to the limit. The officiating crew was very experienced, and in fact no first year c.i.t. was used as a referee.

I thank all the staff for a job well done, and all the campers who dove head first into our program and got as much out of camp as they could. I also thank Bill Margolin for putting his trust in me, and for his constant help and support.

I've put my heart into the camp in my twelve summers here, but it would be impossible to put in as much as I've gotten from it, between the friendships I've made, the great times I've had, and the lessons I've learned.

I love West End House Camp, and I hope all the campers who were lucky enough to be here this summer learned to love it too. The spirit of the House will never die.
