#### LETTER FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR

When I was fourteen, I overheard my counselor, Alex Berger, ask another staff man "What can we do to make today an exciting day?" I remembered that, and in my two years as program director I have always used that question as my guiding principle. This year, between camp and bunk trips, intercamp sports, fantastic night activities, the West End Carnival, superstars, and other new or improved camp programs; and with the efforts of a super staff, I think we would have made Alex proud just about every day.

a staff of 40 counselors, filled with W.E.H. veterans who really know what West End House is all about. A hard working nurse was here all summer taking care of our medical needs, and our cooks did a splendid job at the task of feeding 160 West Enders.

In intercamp sports, W.E.H. was a force which other camps feared. We went to the semi-finals of the Robin Hook 13 & Under soccer tourney, and the finals of the Samoset baseball tourney. West End won both the Robin Hood 13 & Under and the 15 & Under basketball tournaments, prompting their program director to label W.E.H. a "basketball powerhouse."
