What are the dates of Old Timers' Week?

The dates for OTW are August 22-29, 2021.

Why is proof of Covid-19 vaccination required to attend?

Without vaccinations, we would require mask wearing and social distancing, which would be nearly impossible to follow and enforce. Also, with people arriving at different times during the week and leaving camp during their stay for dining, golf, and other activities, we could not maintain a safe “bubble”. With all attendees vaccinated we will have both the safest and most enjoyable OTW.

Why do vaccinated people care whether or not I am vaccinated?

We are sharing indoor spaces. Unvaccinated people are at an increased risk of getting the virus themselves and arriving at camp Covid-positive, which increases the risk of transmission to both unvaccinated and vaccinated people. Our alumni network consists of people of all different ages and with unique health issues, and our goal is to minimize risk as much as possible.

What if I have a health issue that prevents me from getting the Covid-19 vaccination?

We encourage you to consult with your doctor. If you choose not to get the vaccination, we are simply asking you to delay your OTW attendance until 2022.

What if I have difficulty uploading my vaccination card online?

Can I show up to OTW with my vaccination card instead of uploading it online?

No. For this year, everyone attending must pre-register and provide proof of vaccination when doing so.
